Our Practice Nurses will provide advice and immunisations for short, non-complex holidays abroad, i.e. **less than 1 month in one country only.** Please complete the attached form and make a telephone consultation with the Practice Nurse.

If you attend any of the above travel clinics and once you have had the necessary risk assessment, if any of the vaccinations <u>listed below</u> are required, please hand in your printed travel assessment to the Academy Medical Centre reception who will arrange an appointment with the Practice Nurse for you to receive any of the below mentioned vaccines. <u>Without the information from the travel clinic</u> assessment the Nurse may not be able to help you.

- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis A+B (combination)
- Hepatitis A and Typhoid (combination)
- Diphtheria/Tetanus/Polio
- Meningitis ACWY
- Typhoid

The Academy Medical Centre will administer the <u>above vaccinations for FREE</u>. Any other vaccine recommended by the private clinic will be provided by them. Malaria prophylaxis in most cases is by private prescription and cost is determined by the pharmacy.

4 Steps to Travel Vaccinations and Advice for Academy Medical Centre Patients Step 1: Attend Private Travel Clinic (at least 8 weeks before date of travel) or complete Academy Medical Centre Travel Form (only if holiday is less than one month and one destination). Step 2: If free vaccines are required (see list above), hand in third party travel assessment or completed AMC Travel Form Reception to arrange telephone appointment with Practice Nurse Step 3: Our Practice Nurse will contact you to discuss and arrange an immunisation schedule (for free vaccines). Step 4: Our Practice Nurse will administer vaccinations (as listed on prescription) at no cost to you.
